



## Tour Application

PLEASE READ THOROUGHLY

Bike2Bike's Tour Application contains many details about being accepted as a participant, participation requirements, and policies relating to tour participation.

### APPLICATION

Each participant must complete a Tour Application, Agreement, and Waiver.

### AGE

Tour participants must be a minimum of 14 years of age by the date of the Tour's completion. A parent or guardian must sign for and ride with those participants under the age of 18 years old.

### DEPOSIT & BALANCE DUE

Complete the Tour Application form and pay the deposit (30% of the Tour cost). Because of the popularity of our tours, it is important that you complete the application form and pay the deposit as early as possible. Complete one Tour Application for each individual please.

Full payment is due 45 days before a tour's departure date, if final payment is not received when due, we reserve the right to cancel the application. **No invoices will be sent.**

### CONFIRMATION INFORMATION

Upon receipt of your application it will be reviewed, we will send you a confirmation packet when it is accepted. Your confirmation packet will contain a Tour Confirmation Invoice, Travel Insurance information, and Bike2Bike's "Are Your Ready to Ride" booklet to help you to prepare yourself and your equipment for an awesome adventure. Our staff is always available to answer questions either by phone or email.

### CANCELLATIONS

In order to maintain reasonable trip prices, we cannot make exceptions to our cancellation policy. Should you need to cancel your trip for any reason, you must notify the Bike2Bike **in writing** immediately.

The following cancellation policy applies:

- Written cancellation received more than 45 days before the tour date: **Loss of 10% of the total tour cost.**

- Written cancellation received less than 45 days and more than 25 days before the tour date: **Loss of 50% of the total tour cost.**
- Written cancellation received less than 25 days before the tour date: **Loss of full tour cost.**

There is no refund for arriving late for a tour. Should you choose to leave a tour at any time after the tour start time, regardless of the reason, you will not receive a refund. Once a tour has started there is no refund for food, services, or overnights that you have paid for but do not use. Bike2Bike reserves the right to cancel or combine tours. If this results in a revised departure date unacceptable to you, all payments will be refunded. Transfers are allowed within 13 months, with a transfer fee of \$100.00.

#### **NOTE!**

Avoid purchasing non-refundable travel tickets before confirming through Bike2Bike that your tour is a definite go 45 days prior to the departure date.

#### **TRAVEL INSURANCE**

It is our sincere wish for every tour participant to attend and complete the tour of their choice. In an effort to plan for unexpected personal emergencies, health issues, weather, and transportation problems that might cause you to cancel or shorten your tour, travel insurance is strongly advised. Bike2Bike cannot make exception to its cancellation policy. Travel insurance may cover these losses.

## AGREEMENT

I understand participating in a Bike2Bike tour or event [herein called a "Bike2Bike event" or "event"] is potentially hazardous. I reviewed, understand and agree to the following terms and conditions for my participation in a Bike2Bike event.

I will only participate in an event if I am medically able to do so and I am properly trained. I will undergo any prescribed medical treatment in the event of an accident or illness during a Bike2Bike event.

I fully assume all risk of illness, injury, or death, and release and discharge Bike2Bike, Inc. and its employees, agents, assigns, and volunteers from all actions, claims, or demands for damages arising out of my participation in a Bike2Bike event. The foregoing release shall be binding upon me, my heirs, executors/administrators, including my family members.

*To maximize activity enjoyment for participating members, Bike2Bike, Inc. reserves the right to deny an event registration and deny further participation during an activity if a participant's actions are inappropriate and cannot be corrected. In exercising this right, Bike2Bike, Inc. will consider the following grounds, including but not limited to: inaccurate or incomplete registration; physical inability to participate; inadequate equipment or training for the event; unsatisfactory behavior which is dangerous, detrimental or otherwise interferes with the enjoyment of an event group; expulsions or unjustified withdrawals from a prior event. Bike2Bike will advise each applicant in writing within 30 days of receipt of an application whether it accepts the application. If a problem arises after Bike2Bike has accepted an application, the participant will have a reasonable opportunity to remedy the problem.*

I agree to all conditions stated and will follow the instructions and suggestions in the Bike2Bike "Are You Ready to Ride" booklet that will be sent to me upon acceptance of my application.

## TRAVEL INSURANCE

I understand that travel insurance is optional and available to cover some unforeseen cancellations or emergencies.

*It is Bike2bike's sincere wish for each tour or event participant to attend and complete the event chosen. In an effort to plan for unexpected personal emergencies, health issues, weather, and transportation problems that might cause you to cancel or shorten your Tour, travel insurance is strongly advised. Please consult your insurance agent or one of the links on our website, about cost and coverage.*

## CANCELLATIONS

If I must cancel my Tour reservation for any reason, it is my responsibility to notify Bike2Bike immediately in writing via U.S. mail or email (Bob@Bike2Bike.org)

Bike2Bike's cancellation policy is as follows:

- Cancellation more than 45 days before Tour start date: loss of 10% of total Tour Cost
- Cancellation less than 45 days but more than 25 days

before Tour start date: loss of 50% of total Tour Cost.

- Cancellation less than 25 days before Tour start date: loss of full Tour Cost.

### **NO REFUND WILL BE GIVEN:**

- For a participant's late arrival for a Tour
- If a participant chooses to leave a Tour for any reason after the Tour start date
- Once a Tour has started, for food, services, or overnight lodging for which a participant paid but did not use

Bike2Bike, Inc reserves the right to cancel or combine events. If this results in a revised departure date unacceptable to a participant the participants payments will be refunded.

**In order maintain reasonable Tour prices, we cannot make exceptions to the policies above.**

**NOTE!** Avoid purchasing non-refundable travel tickets before confirming through Bike2Bike that your Tour is a definite go 60 days prior to the activity start date.

I understand that Bike2Bike, Inc. reserves the right to make photographic records of its activities, and any photographic records that I may give to Bike2Bike, Inc., and I agree that, without compensation to me, Bike2Bike may use such photographic records for promotional and commercial purposes.

This agreement shall be interpreted according to the laws of the State of Utah and is subject to binding arbitration under the Utah Uniform Arbitration Act. Venue for any court proceeding shall be the district courts of Davis County, Farmington, Utah.

**I read and understand Bike2Bike's policies, including those stated above, and agree to the terms and conditions stated in this agreement and in the Application. I agree that the terms of this agreement shall be binding on Bike2Bike only if Bike2Bike accepts my Tour Application.**

## ACCIDENT WAIVER AND RELEASE OF LIABILITY

In consideration of being allowed to participate I acknowledge that this athletic event is an extreme test of a person's physical and mental limits and carries with it the potential for death, serious injury and property loss. The risks include, but are not limited to, those caused by terrain, facilities, temperature, weather, condition of athletes, equipment, vehicular traffic, actions of other people including, but not limited to, participants, volunteers, spectators, producers of the event, and lack of hydration. These risks are not only inherent to athletics, but are also present for volunteers. I hereby assume all of the risks of participating and/or volunteering in this event. I realize that liability may arise from negligence or carelessness on the part of the persons or entities being released, from dangerous or defective equipment or property owned, maintained or controlled by them, or myself, or because of their possible liability without fault.

I certify that I am physically fit, have sufficiently trained for participation in the event, and have not been advised otherwise by a qualified medical person.

I acknowledge that this Accident Waiver and Release of Liability (AWRL) form will be used by the event holders, sponsors and organizers, in which I may participate and that it will govern my actions and responsibilities at said events.

In consideration of my application and permitting me to participate in this event, I hereby take action for myself, my executors, administrators, heirs, next of kin, successors, and assigns as follows: (A) Waive, Release and Discharge from any and all liability for my death, permanent disability, personal injury, property damage, property theft or actions of any kind which may hereafter accrue to me or my traveling to and from this event, THE FOLLOWING ENTITIES OR PERSONS: Bike2Bike; their directors, officers, employees, volunteers, representatives, and agents, the event holders, event sponsors, event directors, the States of Utah, Arizona, Colorado, Nevada, & New Mexico; all Federal, State, & Local Municipalities, and other governmental entities, churches, clubs, and campgrounds that may be included in this event. (B) Indemnify and Hold Harmless the entities or persons mentioned in this paragraph from any and all liabilities or claims made by other individuals or entities as a result of any of my actions during this event.

I hereby consent to receive medical treatment which may be deemed advisable in the event of injury, accident and or illness during this event. I agree to wear an ANSI, SNELL, or CPSC approved bicycle helmet at all times while riding a bicycle during the events, to refrain from using a headset with more than one ear bud in use, and to abide by the rules, laws, and regulations applicable during my participation in this event and while riding my bicycle.

I understand that at this event or related activities, I may be photographed. I agree to allow my photo, video or film likeness to be used for any legitimate purpose by the event holders, producers, sponsors, organizers and or assigns. I agree my email address may be used for any legitimate purpose by the event holders, producers, sponsors, organizers and or assigns

This AWRL shall be construed broadly to provide a release & waiver to the maximum extent permissible under applicable law. This agreement shall be interpreted according to the laws of the State of Utah and is subject to binding arbitration under the Utah Uniform Arbitration Act. Venue for any court proceeding shall be the district courts of Davis County, Farmington, Utah
